



# UC Presidential Fellowship for Undocumented Graduate Students

**DEADLINE TO APPLY: March 3, 2017 at 12:00pm**

The Graduate Division is pleased to announce a new fellowship for undocumented graduate students. This fellowship is intended to fill a critical gap in graduate and professional student support.

For the purposes of this fellowship, eligible students will include undocumented students who qualify for DACA, AB540, or neither of these programs. Priority for funding will be given to those who are not eligible for other sources of support.

## Award Amount

Eligible graduate students, including professional school students, are invited to apply for this fellowship. Up to four \$5,000 need-based fellowships will be awarded for the period of April 2017 through June 2017.

## Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following **minimum** criteria:

1. Be an enrolled, undocumented UCI graduate student in good academic standing. For the purposes of this fellowship, eligible students will include undocumented students who qualify for DACA, AB540, or neither of these programs. Priority for funding will be given to those who are not eligible for other sources of support.
2. Demonstrate financial need.

## Application Process

Applications will be evaluated using the following criteria:

- Demonstration of financial need
- Academic achievements and promise

Application packages should include the following:

- A completed Application Form
- Note: A letter of recommendation from a faculty member may be provided, but is completely optional.

## Deadline for Submission

Applications must be received by the Graduate Division no later than **Friday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 at 12:00pm (noon)**.
