SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Assisting faculty and staff in understanding the review process for new graduate programs and in preparing proposals for review (in collaboration with other campus offices)
- Conducting research on programs and academic policy
- Providing specific information to deans, faculty, and staff regarding graduate program parameters
- Providing information and guidance on the differences between Self-Supporting Graduate Professional Degree Programs, Professional Degree Supplemental Tuition Programs, and state-supported graduate programs
- Facilitating market research for new Self-Supporting Graduate Professional Degree Programs
